Kirchner Cycles was founded by Scott Kirchner in June 2008. Scott is from a small town in Missouri where he rode his bicycle to school since the first day of kindergarten. Scott spent his summers in Jackson Hole, WY and finally made a connection to a bicycling community that helped him understand the transportation/recreation/community harmony that can be created. While working as a caddy in Jackson, Scott went out of his way to spend all of his money on the newest carbon crank or the fastest wheel set. No matter what components built up the bike, one thing stayed pure; he always rode a steel frame!

“I never could get into a different flavor of material, and it wasn’t because the others weren’t good, they simply didn’t taste the best. It’s like when you go to a restaurant and you can’t help but order the same thing because you’ve tried everything and you know what the best is. And for me that is a steel bicycle.” Scott says.

Scott rode all types of bikes all through high school, piecing together bikes from whatever spare parts he could get his hands on for friends just so they could join him on a campaign of wanderlust filled days.



Those quiet yearnings for something more turned into an outright desire to take fate, quite literally, into his own hands. At the age of 16, Scott got his GED and moved to Springfield, MO. He enrolled at Ozark Technical College(OTC) and received his Associates Degree in Business and Marketing. During his two years of study he worked full time as a bicycle mechanic at A&B Cycle, Springfield’s premiere bike shop. While learning invaluable business skills and a solid welding technique from college, he took yet another bold step on his voyage and started his own bicycle building company. The 19 year old is going to make an impact on the cycle community.

“Everything is in place and I have what it takes to make it happen. This company is me. It just depends purely on how much effort I put into it.”

Kirchner cycles offers many different styles of frames, depending on your preferences and lifestyle. The majority of Kirchner bicycles are going to be lugged frames with drop outs to accommodate for single speed or fixed gear commuting. Also you will see our bicycles with internal geared hubs. The reason we are making so many bikes without external moving parts is because we know stuff gets bent, twisted, and broken. The simpler the bicycle, the easier it is going to be for you. Our standard frame has a relaxed road geometry for more comfort while commuting.
